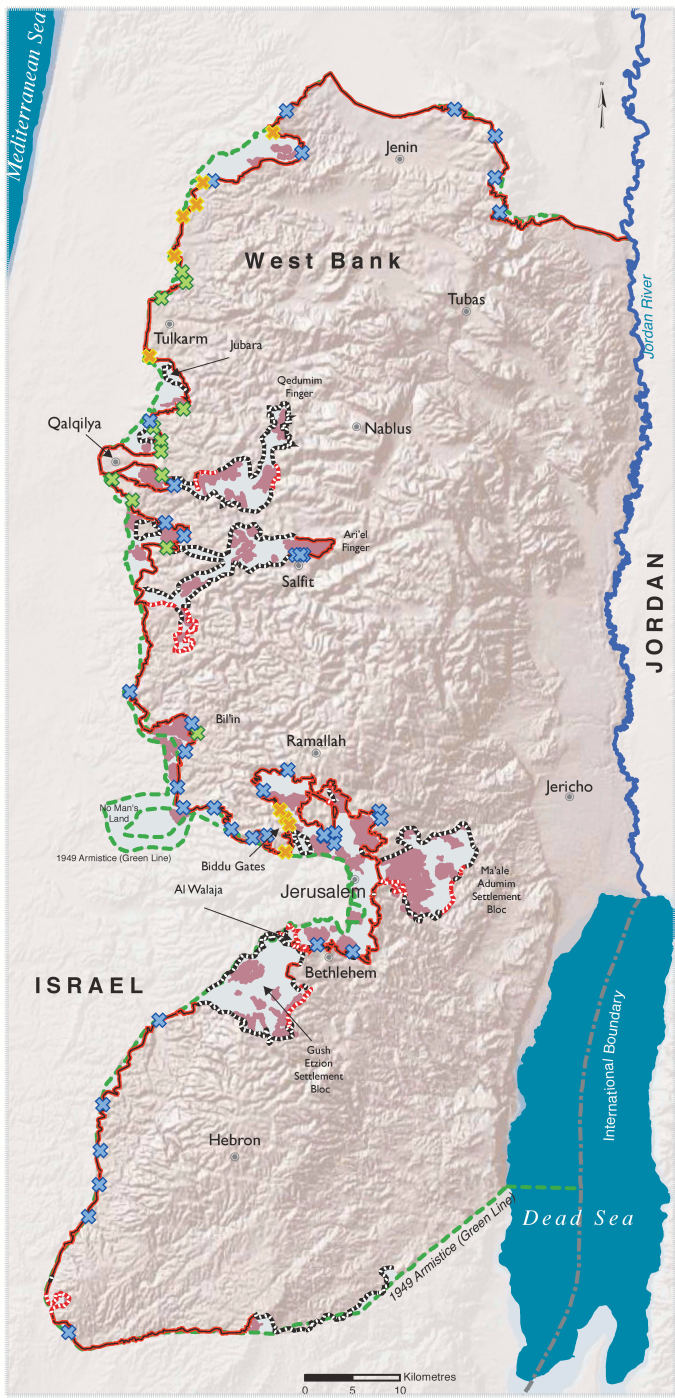

The Barrier Route in the West Bank July 2011



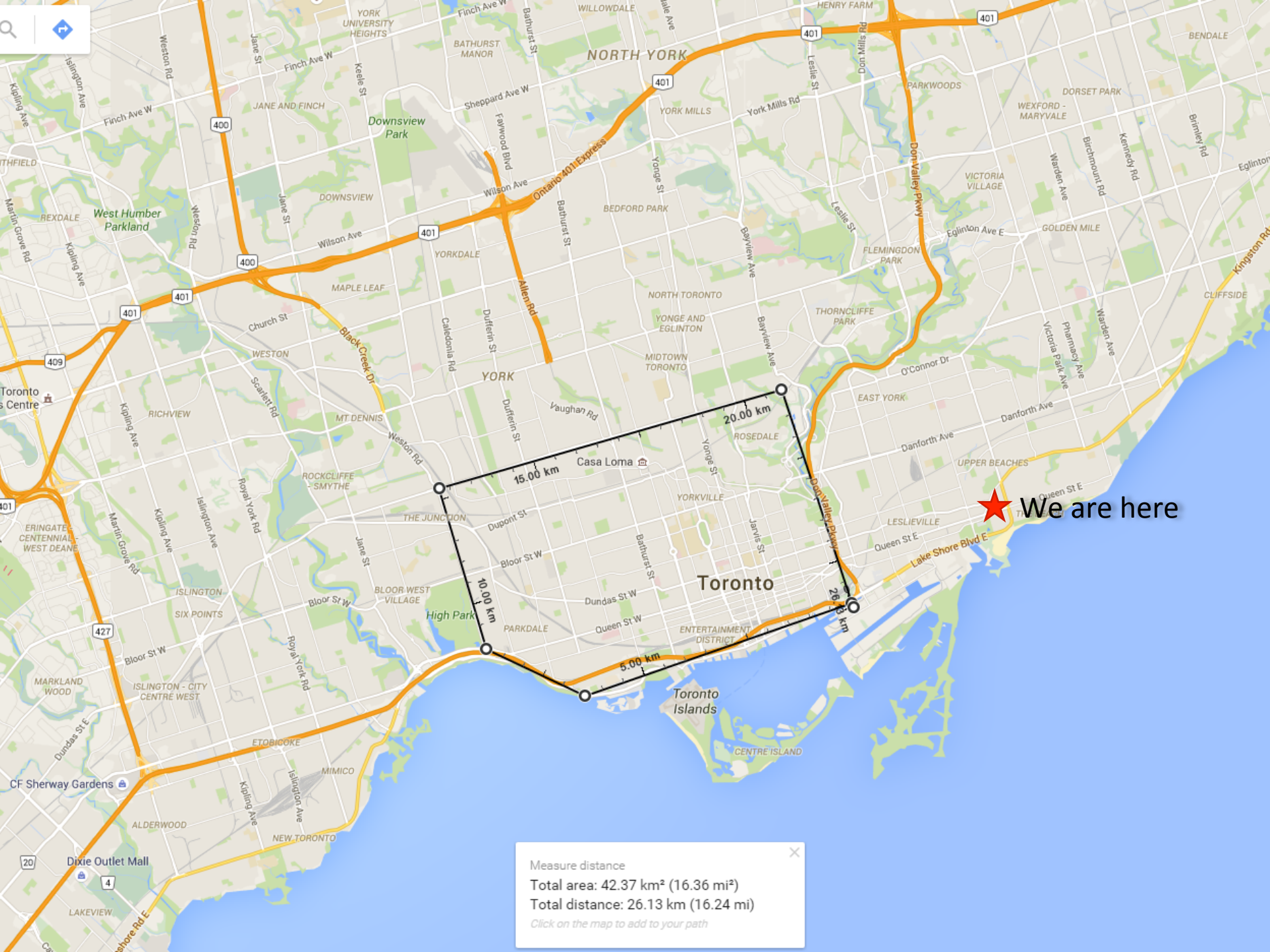

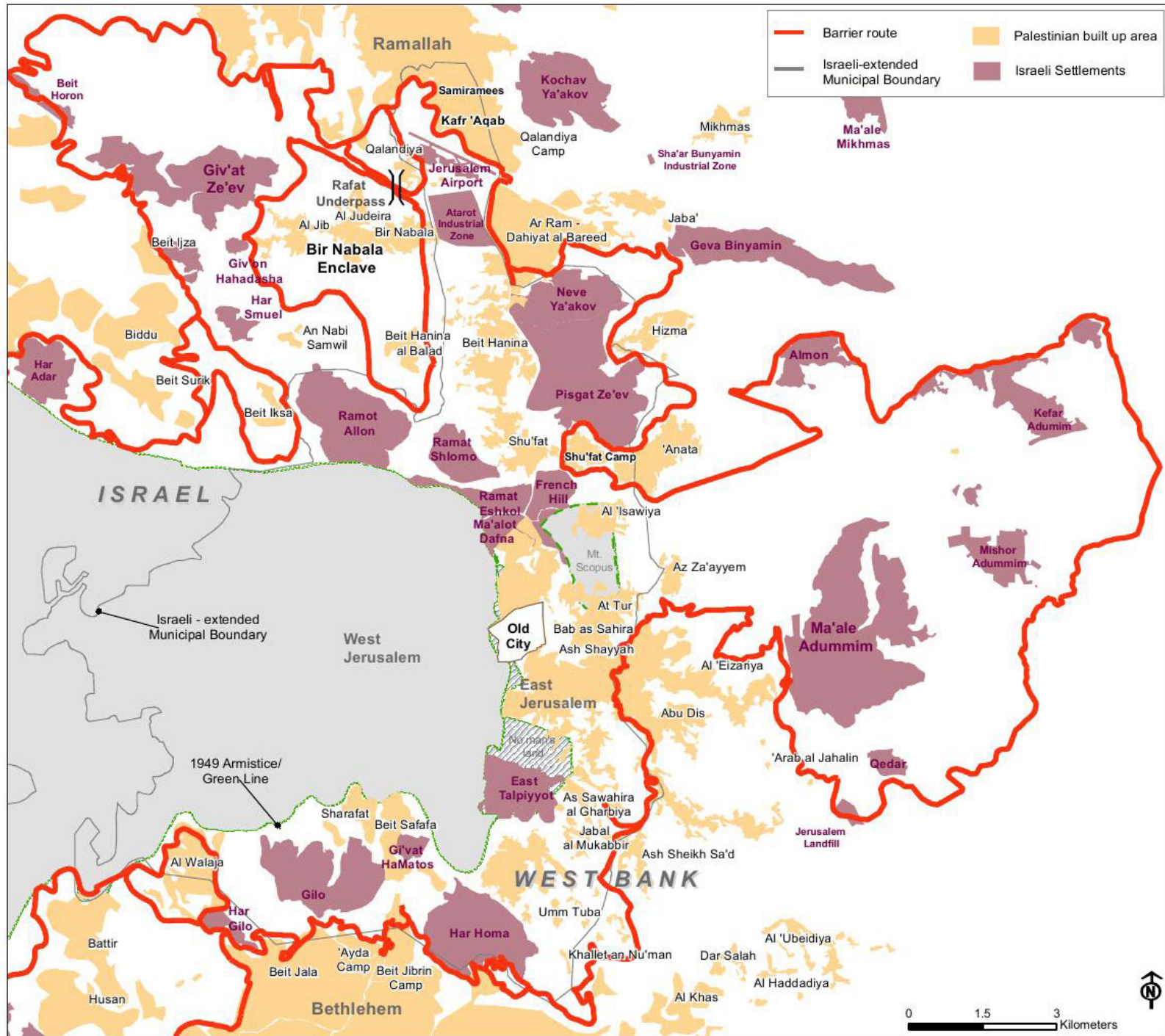

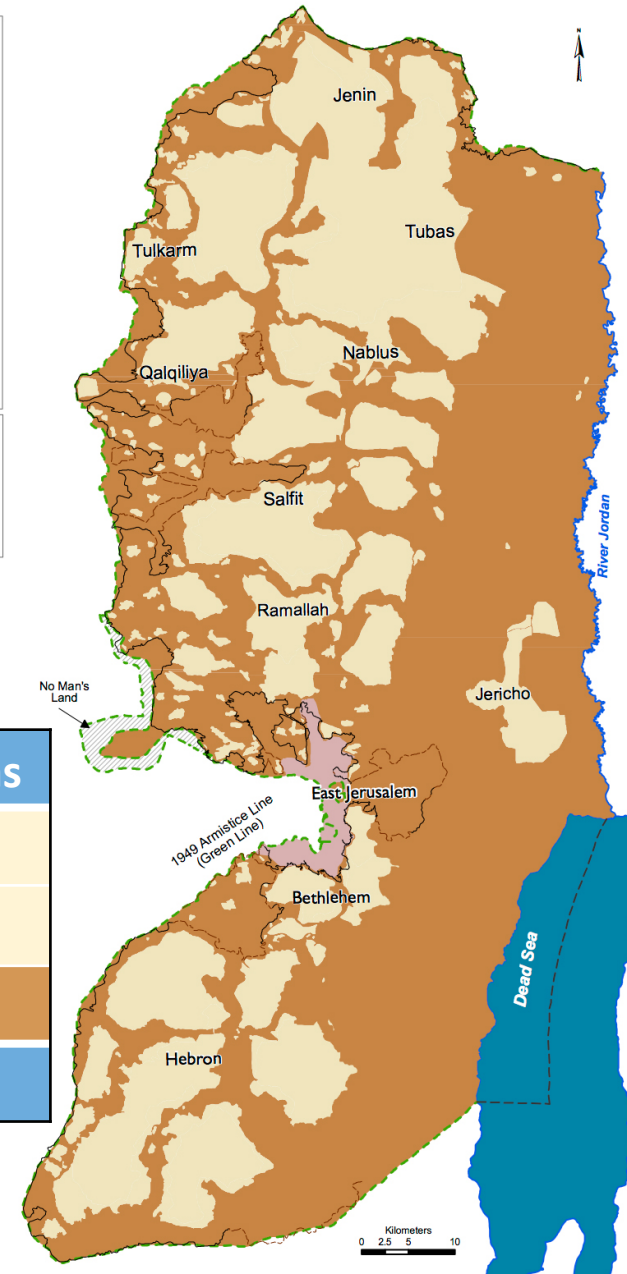

U. N. Resolution 194
 Resolves that the refugees wishing to return to their homes and live at peace with their neighbours should be permitted to do so at the earliest practicable date, and that compensation should be paid to the property of those choosing not to return and for loss of or damage to property which, under principles of international law or equity, should be made good by the Governments or authorities responsible
 Instructs the Conciliation Commission to facilitate the repatriation, resettlement and economic and social rehabilitation of the refugees and the payment of compensation, and maintain close relations with the Director of the U.N. Relief for Palestine Refugees or through him with the appropriate organs and agencies of the U.N.

THE BABY AND THE SOLDIERS
